packs for children in need. Please stay after to help, she would appreciate your kind gesture.





AN ARTICLE FROM THE GRAND LODGE OF SCOTLAND FOR THE HAN YANG LODGE OF KOREA

HOW SHOULD FREEMASONS MEET? ON THE LEVEL

In Ritual page 54, once the lodge has been duly closed, the RWM asks the WSW how Freemasons should meet. The WSW shows his emblem and replies, "on the Level, Right Worshipful Master".

As the lodge has already been closed, this sentence sounds more as a reminder to all the Brethren.

Masons meet on the level, act on the plumb and part on the square. All these tools being those of the 3 principal office bearers. The level means that all masons **are** equal.

It is then recalled during the Tyler's toast, at the very end of Harmony: "We Masons prize that noble truth, the Scottish peasant told, that rank is but a guinea stamp: The man himself the gold. We meet the rich and poo alike, the equal rights maintain".

Similarly, during installation, during the toast to the RWM, Bro. Thomas Reese kept telling me "don't move your glass". The toast meant "I am not under you, I am not over you, I am on your level".

The notion of the level is recalled during the **initiation ceremony** which is a symbolic birth. We all wear the same pajamas, with a cable tow and we are all blindfolded. Also, we were divested of money and all valuable metallic substances. We were equal in the night.

During the initiation, we become brethren. Brotherly love is the first grand principle on which the masonic_order is founded. **All brothers are by definition equal even if, of course, they differ.** We can see it in HanYang as we come from many different countries, we speak different languages and we have very different jobs. Still, in Lodge, we are equal. We are brethren.

Meeting on the level means also to **leave all animosity** behind you when you enter the Lodge. It means to settle all disputes with your Brethren. Ritual page 42: "you should never put on that badge (apron) if you are about to enter a lodge in which there is a brother with whom you entertain animosity. In such cases, it is expected that you will invite him to withdraw in order that you may settle your differences amicable".

Meeting on the level is necessary to work correctly. In Lodge, we are in a sacred place, in which we leave behind us our titles, our ranks, our fortunes, in order to work together to become better men. If there are ranks coming from the profane world, then Masonry cannot operate. A profane is somebody who has not been initiated. *Pro* means in front of and *Fanum* means temple. So the profane stands in front of the doors of the temple, but he is not admitted. In masonry, when we tyle the lodge, we leave our daily life and our problems outside the door in order to work with serenity.

In Korea, where titles are more important than in Europe (Isanim, sajangnim, kwajangnim) because of Confucianism, *I* really admire Korean brethren for being able to work on the level.

A good true story about the level is about President Teddy Roosevelt, who returned to his hometown Lodge to find out that his gardener had become the RWM. And then President Roosevelt had to obey the commands of his gardener while in Lodge. Another illustration in France is that it is customary for the past Master to become the Inner guard, a key role but a humble one.

But, like in the Korean movies, there are Big Brothers (Hyeong Nim) and little brothers. First, there are **3 degrees** Entered Apprentices, Fellowcrafts and Masters. They cannot sit where they want, their aprons are different and only the Masters can vote.

Second, there are **office-bearers** and non-office bearers. The Right Worshipful Master commands the Lodge, assisted by office bearers.

So are we really equal if there is a hierarchy? The answer is that it is a hierarchy of duties.

The degrees correspond to a **level of masonic knowledge.** It is a hierarchy of knowledge and wisdom. It is not a hierarchy of authority and control. If they work, all EAs will pass Fellowcraft and then be raised Master. Purpose is to accompany the



recently initiated brethren through the next degrees not, to keep them down.

Master Masons have the right to vote, but they also have more duties than EAs or Fellowcraft. They have to make sure that the lodge keeps running, by taking offices in the lodge. Masters have to initiate new members and to transmit them masonic values and education. It is a lot of work. And Masters pay dues every year.

About the office bearers, again, we have to obey the RWM because he represents wisdom. It is symbolically the wisdom that we are looking for inside ourselves. Nothing illegal will be asked, it would be against our Constitutions. Office bearers have obviously again **more duties** than non-office bearers. They are not superior to other brethren. And we will change the plates each year so that, in turn, all Brethren have the possibility to exercise those roles in the Lodge if they are ready to accept the incoming responsibilities.

To conclude, I will read a poem "The Mother Lodge" by Rudyard Kipling on his Lodge in India. It was read during my initiation back in France. And it illustrates well what **meeting on the level** is:

There was Rundle, Station Master, An' Beazeley of the Rail, An' 'Ackman, Commissariat, An' Donkin' o' the Jail; An' Blake, Conductor-Sergeant, Our Master twice was 'e, With im that kept the Europe-shop, Old Framjee Eduljee.

Outside - 11 Sergeant! Sir! Salute! Salaam! Inside - 'Brother, 11 an' it doesn't do no 'arm. We met upon the Level an' we parted on the Square, An' I was junior Deacon in my Mother-Lodge out there!

We'd Bola Nath, Accountant, An' Saul the Aden Jew, An' Din Mohammed, draughtsman Of the Survey Office too; There was Babu Chuckerbutty, An' Amir Singh the Sikh, An' Castro from the fittin '-sheds, The Roman Catholick!

Outside - "Sergeant! Sir! Salute! Salaam! Inside - 'Brother, 11 an' it doesn't do no 'arm. We met upon the Level an' we parted on the Square, An' I was junior Deacon in my Mother-Lodge out there!
