



EDITOR'S BLUNDER:

It was brought to my attention that an error was made in the September 2024 Trestleboard regarding GEORGE WASHING-TON LODGE, which was erroneously reported as being Lodge No. 640.

After further research, the following information should be recognized and a correction should be noted:

As it turns out, there were 2 GEORGE WASHINGTON LODGEs which were not related. GEORGE WASHINGTON LODGE NO. 62 was from the CHINESE CAMP who consolidated with TUOLUMNE LODGE NO. 8.

GEORGE WASHINGTON LODGE NO. 525 was the second Lodge to bear the name. They met at PARNASSUS LODGE No. 338 until they owned their own temple.

VERITAS NO. 640 was chartered on October 14, 1926 and merged with JONATHAN NO. 545 to become VERITAS-JONATHAN NO. 545 and who merged with AMITY-SEAL ROCK NO. 370 and became AMITY-SEAL ROCK NO. 370. Hence, the correct Lodge No. is **GEORGE WASHINGTON LODGE NO. 525** which later merged with FAIRMOUNT LODGE #435 to become **GEORGE WASHINGTON #435**.

Thank you brothers for being alert. To further explain our lodge's history, please note the following script, authored by our very own **NICK RAISIS**, Past Master 1986.

Have you ever wondered about the history of our lodge, or why it has two names?

Columbia Brotherhood is the result of two lodges (Columbia #388 and Brotherhood #370) consolidating on October 12, 2005, and moving to our current location.

Both the names Columbia and Brotherhood were the result of earlier consolidations.

In May of this year, I was having dinner with WM JASON HUI and PM FRANCIS FELICIANO at the California Grand York Rite meeting when we started talking about Columbia Lodge and how it started. Jason asked me to write an article about Columbia's early beginnings. If this article seems biased toward Columbia, it is because I was as Senior Deacon for Alta Vista Mt. Vernon when this happened. So here I go.

The Columbia side of the lodge we know today is the result of two lodges, Argonaut-Argonne #461, and Alta Vista-Mt. Vernon #464, consolidating on April 4, 1983. During the talks between the two lodges, it was felt that a new name for the new lodge be considered. Several names were considered, with Columbia becoming the favorite. But our new lodge name was not because of the masonic building in the town of Columbia or anything of a past historic level. We were a new lodge with a new beginning, and there was a new era in space exploration just beginning, the SPACE SHUTTLE PROGRAM, and one of the new shuttles was named COLUMBIA. Hence, we became Columbia Lodge #461. There was even a lapel pin made of a space shuttle saying Columbia #461. Our meeting location was the Scottish Rite Temple on the corner of 19th Ave and Sloat Blvd.

On July 1, 1987, Columbia consolidated with Balder Lodge #393, becoming Columbia-Balder #393. Per the con-



solidation talks, the name Balder was dropped after a few years and we became Columbia #393. Still meeting at the Scottish Rite Temple.

On December 1, 1990, Parnassus-Presidio #388 consolidated with Columbia becoming Columbia #388. With this consolidation, the Parnassus building was sold as no Masonic building could have a vacant owner. This building was at the corner of 9th Ave and Judah St, with a small parking lot that was shared with several business. We still stayed at the Scottish Rite Temple.

You will notice that after each consolidation, whoever had the lowest lodge number became Columbia's number.

Our last consolidation occurred on October 12, 2005, with Brotherhood Lodge #370, becoming Columbia-Brotherhood #370 and moving to our present location. As I mentioned earlier, Brotherhood itself was an umbrella

name for several former lodges.

Here is a list of the lodge names that comprise Columbia-Brotherhood Lodge #370's history, with their charter dates:

Presidio #354 (1903); Amity #370 (1905); Richmond #375 (1906); Parnassus #388 (1907); Balder #393 (1908); Fairmount #435 (1913); Argonaut #461 (1916); Alta Vista #464 (1916); Argonne #514 (1922); Mt. Vernon #517 (1922); George Washington #525 (1922); Seal Rock #536 (1922); Military Service #570 (1923); Jonathan #545 (1923); Veritas #640 (1926); and Hunters Point Naval #706 (1950).

So how did so many lodges end up as Columbia Brotherhood #370?

On the Columbia side: Alta Vista consolidated with Mt Vernon on December 2, 1968; Argonaut consolidated with Argonne on December 5, 1968; and Parnassus consolidated with Presidio on December 1, 1969.

For Brotherhood: Amity #370 consolidated with Seal Rock #536 on March 1, 1963 to become Amity Seal Rock #370; Jonathan #545 consolidated with Veritas #640 on December 3, 1963 to become Jonathan Veritas #545; Richmond #375 consolidated with Military Services #570 on July 1, 1974 to become **Brotherhood #375**; Hunters Point Naval #706 consolidated with George Washington #435 on July 1, 1975 to become George Washington #435; on December 1, 1975, Jonathan Veritas #545 consolidated with Amity Seal Rock #370 to become Amity #370; Amity then consolidated with Brotherhood #375 on July 1, 1987 to become Brotherhood #370. George Washington #435 consolidated with Brotherhood #370 November 1, 1992.

So, even though Columbia Brotherhood turns twenty-five next year, you can see that our Masonic roots extend back over 121 years. Some with interesting traditions, such as Balder's version of "CHEERS." Balder had Scandinavian roots and their version of CHEERS was a sing song of SKOUL done from low to louder three times and on the fourth time SKOUL was very loudly stated.

For more information about these lodges, you can check the Grand Lodge website and go to the resources tab and then proceedings archives. You may also check with our lodge secretary to see what information he may have in the lodge library. I also want to thank **JORDAN YELINEK**, the Assistant Grand Secretary for his help on obtaining the history of this lodge.
